Please select your preferences for service opportunities:

- A Day of Service at the school, which might include painting, clean up, or other service identified as a need by the Administrative staff.
- Tutoring, at lunchtime or afterschool.
- Reading to the children, during a convenient time during the day.
- Mentoring relationships that would include weekly or other regular periodic meetings with youngsters.

Mentoring training is recommended. CADEKids will coordinate mentoring training through United Way, which takes just a couple of hours.

- An adopt-a-school program, that could contain any combination of activities,

but implies a long-term commitment to a particular school(s).

- A presentation on a subject of company specialty, such as savings or healthcare.
- VIP observational visit.
- Adopt-a-School arrangements.
- Principal for a Day service.

CADEKids would also seek your assistance in contacting the school of your choice, and participating in a meeting with school officials to start the process.

CADEKids would work with the school to handle logistics, including background checks, where needed. A background check is not required for a VIP visit.

Background checks are required for adults that will be working with children at school sites, and include child abuse clearance (\$10); criminal history (\$10), and an FBI background check (\$40). CADEKids annually provides this information for all Prevention Specialists.
